His research interests and publications include sleep disordered breathing, swallowing disorders and laryngeal mobility disorders.

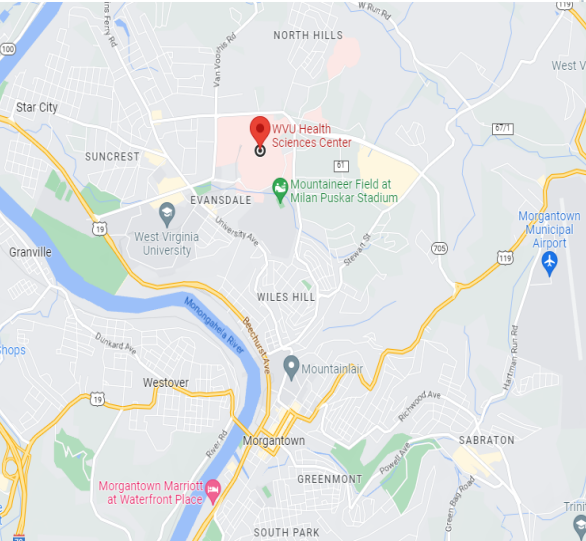
