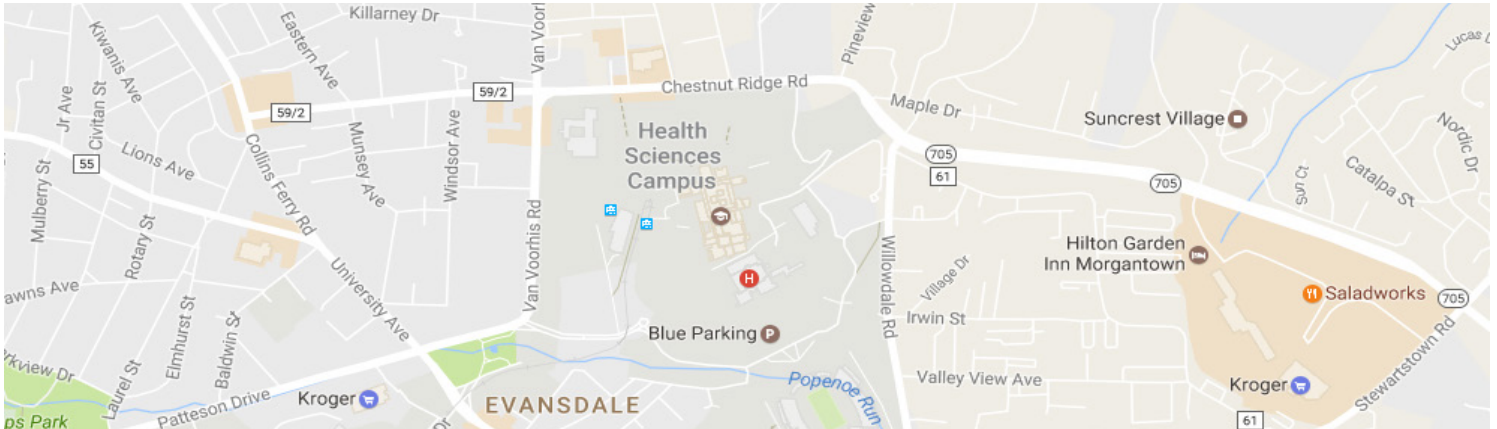

Directions

Traveling from I-79 South

Take exit #155

(WV-7, West Virginia University). Bear right at the bottom of the exit (towards Star City).

Go straight thru 3 lights, passing University Towne Center, Sheetz and crossing over the Star City bridge. At the 4th light at the top of the hill, turn left onto Pattenoe Drive (Coliseum will be on your right). Proceed straight thru 4 lights. At the 5th light (across from Applebees) turn right into parking lot (see parking information below), the parking garage is at the back of the lot.

Once inside the garage, take the elevator to the top floor and follow the walk-way up to the Health Sciences Center building. Signs will be posted to the Fukushima auditorium.

Traveling from I-79 North

Take exit #155 (WV-7, West Virginia University). Turn left at the bottom of the exit (towards Star City). Follow the remaining directions as noted above.

Traveling from I-68 Construction in progress on Easton Hill. Expect delays.

Take Exit #7 (WV-7/Airport/Pierpont Road). Turn right off exit onto Pierpont Road. Take a left at the second stop light and you will climb a winding hill. Go straight through the next stop light and continue onto Rt. 705. Drive through the next 5 traffic lights and at the 6th light take a left onto Van Voorhis Road. At the first light, take a left into the parking lot (see parking information below) where Mountaineer Station Garage is located, 112 Van Voorhis Drive Central, Morgantown, WV 26505.

Parking

Parking is available in the WVU Mountaineer Station Garage, 1112 Van Voorhis Drive Central, Morgantown, WV, 26505. This garage is located across the street from Applebees. Parking in the garage is \$1.25 per hour. There are pay stations inside the lobby and on the 7th floor (cash only no credit or debit cards; there is an ATM located on the first floor of the Mountaineer Station).
